### 7. COVID-19 Recovery Working Committee Report

CEO Daniel Silva reported that the program has been completed and that Finance Director Angie Vela is working on the submission of reimbursement requests with Hidalgo County. He reported that 284 businesses were assisted and \$945,000 was disbursed. Mr. Silva also mentioned that MEDC continues to assist local business. This weekend, a Market Days event will be hosted by MEDC at the Mission Food Park where local businesses will have an opportunity to sell their products. Food sales at the Mission Food Park have been going very well. Sixteen (16) jobs have been created and more trucks have shown an interest to become part of the Mission Food Park.
