## 3. Mission Fire Department Operations Manual # 1200.2.00, Section: Ambulance Procedures

The Mission Fire Department Ambulance Medic Units are BLS units with MIC-U capability that will respond as a backup to the City of Mission contract EMS provider. Patient care shall be the priority responsibility of the crew on the Medic unit. This guide is to establish guidelines for the management of the ambulance response to emergencies.

Mayor Garza recommended to form a committee to review the procedures.

Councilman Plata moved to appoint Mayor, Councilman Flores, Fire Chief Gilbert Sanchez, City Manager Randy Perez, Dr Ivan Melendez, Medical Director a paramedic and a union representative as the committee members. Motion was seconded by Councilman Flores and approved unanimously 4-0.
