Notice of Funding Availability

The City of Mission anticipates receiving approximately \$1,002,485 through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Entitlement Program for fiscal year 2023-24 from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). These funds can be utilized for eligible activities and meet one of the national objectives. Eligible activities include but are not limited to: public services such as, services for seniors, health, youth; housing activities and infrastructure improvements such as water, sewer or drainage. All proposed projects must benefit low- and moderate-income persons.
