The City of Mission anticipates receiving approximately \$992,431 through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Entitlement Program for fiscal year 2026-2027 from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). Eligible activities include but are not limited to: public services such as, services for seniors, health, youth; housing activities and infrastructure improvements such as water, sewer or drainage. All proposed projects must meet one of the following national objectives:

1. Principally benefits low- and moderate-income persons.
2. Aids in the prevention or elimination of slums and blight.
3. Meets a need having a particular urgency.
