I. JOB SUMMARY

This position is a working supervisory position which requires the crew leader to operate heavy equipment. The position requires the incumbent to operate a backhoe, vactor though other light to heavy equipment may be used in assisting, assigning, directing and coordinating the activities of crew members whose responsibilities include but are not limited to: installing, maintaining, repairing, replacing and servicing sewerage infrastructure a (lift stations, pumps, motors, sewer lines, manholes cleanouts wet wells sludge collectors, etc..). Install repair or replace of manhole ring and covers. Examines sewer pipes to detect leaks and repair them sometimes in inclement weather of dark of night. Will repair sewer system pipes and accessories using equipment such as pneumatic jackhammer, power drills, power saws, plumber's tools. Reports to Supervisor on areas worked and status of job or project. This position is on a mandatory rotating on call list. Individual will perform other duties assigned by the supervisor/department head as needed.

II. EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

- ➤ High school diploma or G.E.D is required.
- > Requires Class II wastewater collection certificate or ability to test and acquire these certificates within two (2) years from the date of hire.
- Must be able to obtain a Class B with tanker endorsement drivers license issued by the Texas Department of Public Safety within six months from date of hire.
- Must have two years experience with backhoe, utility construction and plumbing practices.

III. EMPLOYMENT REQUIREMENTS

- Applicant will be subject to a complete background investigation. Incomplete, inaccurate and/or failure to report information will cause the applicant rejection from consideration.
- Applicant must take and pass a drug, physical, and pre-placement screenings administered by the City of Mission doctor at the City's expense.
- Applicant must have a current valid class "C" driver's license from the Texas department of Public Safety with no more than two (2) moving traffic violations within the past two (2) years.
- Applicant must meet all other department and City employment standards.

IV. SKILL AND ABILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Ability to follow a firm work schedule as directed by supervisor.
- Ability to deal with public relation issues and various types of citizen inquiries tactfully, courteously, and in a business manner.
- Ability to follow instructions orally or in written form and perform tasks with little or no supervision.

- Must work at night or during inclement weather and especially during emergency situations.
- Assigns work duties to crew members regarding excavations, back filling trenches and culverts.
- > Assists in the installing, repairing, and replacing of sewer mains and pipeline.
- Examines sewer pipes to detects leaks and informs consumer of any interruption of service.
- Install, repair or replace sewer pipe, manholes or cleanouts.
- Operates mainline valve to close water flow through line.
- Communicates with other workers in performing routine operations and maintenance.
- Reports to supervisor and advises supervisor of job or project status.
- Interprets City policy and procedures as related to assigned job.
- Perform all duties of the job with special attention to safety and proper procedure related to the job position.
- Maintain a working rapport with other crews and management.
- Supervise crew members.
- Supervise and assist crew in policing work areas.
