1. Call to Order

With a quorum being present, Mayor Dr. Armando O’caña called the meeting to order at 10:30 a.m.

2. Approval of Resolution # 1653 of the City Council of the City of Mission Extending Disaster Declaration issued on March 13, 2020 regarding COVID-19 Pandemic

On March 13, 2020 Governor Greg Abbot declared a state of disaster for all counties in Texas. Mayor Armando O’caña determined that extraordinary measures needed to be taken for the city and therefore issued a declaration of disaster for the City of Mission to proclaim the existence or threatened existence of a local emergency when the City of Mission is affected or likely to be affected by a public calamity.

Executive Order GA-14 of the Governor of the State of Texas was adopted in its entirety, specifically as to matters that pertained to the city, and remained in effect until the state of disaster was terminated or to run concurrent with subsequent Executive Orders or extension is issued by the Governor thereof extending beyond April 30, 2020 at 11:59 p.m.

Emergency Order of the County of Hidalgo dated March 22, 2020 was adopted in its entirety, specifically as to matters that pertained to the city, and remained in effect until the state of disaster was terminated or was to run concurrent with subsequent Emergency Order or extension is issued by the county thereof extending beyond April 10, 2020 at 11:59 p.m

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Councilwoman Jessica Ochoa moved to approve Resolution #1653 Extending Disaster Declaration issued regarding COVID-19 Pandemic and extend declaration to coincide with the Governor's Declaration to end April 30, 2020 at 11:59 p.m. and approved County of Hidalgo Emergency Order issued March 22, 2020 to run concurrent with subsequent Emergency Order extending beyond April 10, 2020 at 11:59 p.m. Motion was seconded by Councilman Plata and approved unanimously 4-0

Immediate action is required because of an imminent threat and possibility of exposure to disease, prevent the spread of and control the risk of disease, in order to promote the public health, safety and welfare of residents of the City of Mission.
