

**RESOLUTION # 1652**

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MISSION, TEXAS  
POSTPONING THE MAY 2, 2020 GENERAL ELECTION UNTIL NOVEMBER 3, 2020**

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Proclamation issued by Governor Greg Abbott on March 18, 2020 suspending Sections 41.0052 (a) and (b) of the Texas Election Code to the extent necessary to allow political subdivisions that would otherwise hold elections on May 2, 2020, to move their General Election for 2020 only to the next uniform election date, occurring on November 3, 2020 without otherwise adjusting the term of office; and

WHEREAS, Under Art. XVI, Section 17 of the Texas Constitution, the individuals who currently hold the offices of City Council Places 2 and 4 to be on the ballot on the May uniform election date will continue to exercise the duties of those offices until the new officers take their oaths of office, following the November uniform election date; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mission will be preserving all candidate filings for City Council Place 2 and Place 4 and ballot order that has already taken place will remain as is, candidate filings will not be reopened; and


WHEREAS, all ABBMs for voters that are voting by mail due to being over the age of 65 or due to disability will still be valid for the postponed election. ABBMs for voters who submitted ABBMs based on expected absence from the county will not be valid for the postponed election; and

WHEREAS, voter registration deadline to vote in the November 3, 2020 election will be on October 5, 2020, the deadline to submit an ABBM will be October 23, 2020 and the dates for early voting will be October 19, 2020 thru October 30, 2020.

WHEREAS, upon approval of the resolution the City of Mission will make the necessary revisions to the original Election Order before the deadline of August 17, 2020.

NOW THEREFORE, we the City Council of the City of Mission, Texas do hereby approve the postponement of the May 2, 2020 General Election for City Council Place 2 and 4 for November 3, 2020.
