#### I. JOB SUMMARY

Individual performs a combination of the following duties. Responsible for maintaining golf carts to ensure proper working condition and clubhouse surroundings. Checks for damage and washes golf carts on a daily basis. Fixes flat tires and performs other minor repairs (e.g. replaces bearings, wheels, handles, etc.). Assists in testing and recharging batteries. May check minor electrical wiring and replace electrical accessories such as horn and headlights. May tow golf cart from the course as directed. Perform minor carpentry work to enhance clubhouse surroundings. May clean and sweep bag storage rooms. Throw trash from all areas of the clubhouse, inside or outside. restroom for any minor plumbing or electrical repairs as needed (faucet, urinals, and wall socket). May also perform delivery and pickup duties using city vehicle as required. May assist in tournament operations as directed. Individual is also responsible in keeping inventory records on equipment used, including MODS sheets for clubhouse. May perform other cleaning duties such as washing cart barn floor, and cleaning pump area using soap and acidic water. Vacuums restaurant daily and cleans all windows in the clubhouse. Individual will be assigned other duties when needed by supervisor/Golf Director.

#### II. EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

- ➤ High school diploma or G.E.D. is desirable, but not required.
- ➤ At least six to twelve months experience and/or knowledge of service and maintenance of golf carts.
- ➤ One (1) year experience in small engine repairs is required.
